2022 Block of the Month: It's Christmas All Year Long

Block #6: Gift

Instructions:

You will need three fabrics: Fabric A: Background fabric

Fabric B: Package Fabric C: Ribbon



From Fabric A: Cut the following

One - 3" square

Two - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

From Fabric B: Cut the following

One - $6" \times 10"$ rectangle

From Fabric C: Cut the following

One - 3" square

One - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

One - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × 10" rectangle





Sewing:

Step 1: Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams throughout.

Step 2: Using the Half Square Triangle (HST) method, take the 3" squares each of Fabrics A and Fabric C to make two Fabric A/C units. Trim to $2\frac{1}{2}$ ' square. Sew the two Fabric A rectangles $(1\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $2\frac{1}{2}$ ") to the HST units, as shown. This block will finish at $2\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".





Step 3: Cut the Fabric B rectangle in half vertically to form two 3" x 10" rectangles. Sew the Fabric C, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10" rectangle, between the Fabric B rectangles. Cut this $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10" rectangle in half horizontally and sew the Fabric C, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle between. This block should finish to $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".







Step 4: Sew the two blocks in Step 2 and 3 together, as shown.





Block #6, Gift, will measure 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " by 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished and 6" by 12" in the quilt.
