## 2022 Block of the Month: It's Christmas All Year Long

Block \#2: Star
Instructions:
You will need three fabrics:
Fabric A: Background fabric
Fabric B: Star fabric
Fabric C: Points fabric


## Cutting:

From Fabric A: Cut the following
Four - $4 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Eight-2 $\frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime}$ squares
From Fabric B: Cut the following One-4 $\frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime}$ square Eight-2 $\frac{1^{\prime \prime}}{}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares
From Fabric C: Cut the following Four - $4 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares


Sewing:
Step 1: Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams throughout.
Step 2: Use the Stitch and Flip Method to make the point blocks. Draw a line on the diagonal on the Fabric $A$ and $B 2 \frac{1_{2}^{\prime \prime}}{}$ squares. Layer right sides together (RST) the Fabric C $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares with two Fabric $A$ and two Fabric B $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. See photo. Notice the placement of the Fabric $A$ and $B$ squares.


Stitch on the line. Cut $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line. Press. Trim the point blocks to $4 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square, if needed.

Step 3: Per the photo, lay the squares in rows. Sew the rows together. Press the even rows in one direction and the odd rows in the opposite direction. Join the rows.


Block \#2, Star, will measure $12 \frac{1^{\prime \prime}}{}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square unfinished and $12^{\prime \prime}$ square in the quilt.
