## 2022 Block of the Month: It's Christmas All Year Long

Block #11: Candles

Instructions:

You will need five fabrics:

Fabric A: Background fabric

Fabric B: Bowl

Fabric C: Bowl Rim

Fabric D: Candles

Fabric E: Flames



From Fabric A: Cut the following

Two -  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Twelve - 1" squares

Six - 1" x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

One -  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

One -  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square

Two -  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

Two -  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

One -  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

From Fabric B: Cut the following

One - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

From Fabric C: Cut the following

One - 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

From Fabric D: Cut the following

One - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

One - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

One -  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

From Fabric E: Cut the following

Three -  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles







## Sewing:

Step 1: Use  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams throughout. Right Sides Together (RST) puts the fabric pieces with right sides facing.


Step 2: Sew the Fabric B Base to the Fabric C Rim, RST. Press. Using the Stitch and Flip Method, draw a line on the diagonal on the Fabric A 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Layer right sides together (RST) the Base/Rim piece with two Fabric A pieces. See photo. Stitch on the line. Cut  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line. Press. Note the direction of the stitch lines.







Step 3: Using the same Stitch and Flip method, draw a line on the diagonal on the Fabric A 1" squares. Layer right sides together (RST) the Fabric E with two Fabric A pieces. See photo. Stitch on the line. Cut  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line. Press. Note the direction of the stitch lines. Layer Fabric E with two more Fabric A pieces. See photo. Stitch, trim and press as before, noting the direction of the stitch lines. Make three Flame pieces. They will measure 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$  3  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".








Step 4: Per the photo, stitch two Fabric A 1"  $\times$  3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles to each side of the flame piece.



Join the candle blocks in columns. See photo. Column 1:  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D and flame piece. Column 2:  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D, flame piece and  $1\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A. Column 3:  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D, flame piece and  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square Fabric A.



Sew the candle section columns together with the Fabric A 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$  8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and the 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$  8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. See photo.



Step 5: Join the rows together: the 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A, the candle section, and the bowl

section.





Block #11, Candles, will measure 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " by 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished and 12" by 12" in the quilt.
